DEVELOPMENT SHOWCASE

Burnside Riverside Quarter, Aberdeen

Burnside is an-award winning development in Aberdeenshire, part of an urban quarter focused on the regeneration of Davidson's Paper Mill. The creation of a green corridor around the watercourse, with pedestrian footbridges across it and helps connect the community and provides a sense of arrival.

Derwenthorpe, York

Derwenthorpe is a partnership scheme with the Joseph Rowntree Housing Trust on this multi award-winning development of contemporary homes. The development layout puts people at the centre of the community; a third of the site is public open space and park areas. All homes incorporate green features and materials to promote sustainable and affordable living.

Nine Elms Point, Central London

This development forms part of the Vauxhall Nine Elms Battersea Opportunity Area, which is the largest regeneration project ever undertaken in London. The development comprises three towers of 18, 27 and 37 stories respectively, with an 83,088 sq ft flagship Sainsbury's superstore providing a base for part of the development. Residents will also be able to use a private entrance to Nine Elms tube station, which has recently opened.

Trumpington Meadows, Cambridge

Trumpington Meadows is an award-winning development, providing 1,200 contemporary homes set in 148 acres of waterside country park. The development is providing a wide mix of new homes to help meet local housing needs, with 60% for private sale and 40% affordable. They offer residents a 'greener' way of life: as well as being set within parkland, providing allotments and access to a future orchard on the River Cam.









FAQS

What experience do I need?

It is not essential that you have experience working in the construction industry. The most important thing you can bring to our business is your personality. You will need to be able to work in a diverse environment, bring skills and attributes from a whole host of backgrounds and also be passionate about customers and people.

What happens during the 'block week' with Sheffield Hallam University on the Higher and Degree Apprenticeships?

During your block week, you will complete activities, lectures and assignments with your peers on the programme from the business. This allows you to reflect, share good practice and draw upon each other's experiences. Within the block weeks, you may also sit exams. The delivery will be made up of a blend of classroom studies at Sheffield Hallam University, where you will be put up in accommodation nearby, and online learning.

What support is available?

Within the division you work in, you will be supported by your own mentor who will conduct quarterly reviews with you and discuss your progress at university and also within your role. Sheffield Hallam University appoint a Course Leader and Work-Based Learning Coach who work with Barratt to ensure your progress is tracked and any additional support needs are identified. You must inform us if you require any additional learning support as this is also offered through the university. Don't forget, you also have peer support from colleagues.

How much time will I need to set for work outside of university?

The time you require to complete set assignments will be down to you as an individual. There are assignments that need to be completed in your own time. You will need to be self-motivated to undertake wider reading in order to explore what you have learned during your block weeks in more depth. It's up to you to set your own study schedule to ensure you are ready to submit your coursework or take exams.

In addition to your block weeks, you will have the opportunity to get involved with a variety of learning activities related to your job role, outside of your normal day-to-day responsibilities.

How much will the Degree cost me?

The course is fully funded and you will not be required to contribute to the cost of your qualification.

As a comparison, if you were to take the traditional route and study for a degree on a full-time university course, the fees would cost you in the region of £27,000.





ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To join a Higher or Degree Apprenticeship in Construction, Commercial or Technical, you must have a keen interest in customer expectation and commercial needs. It's a big commitment: you'll need to manage real work while furthering your education.

To qualify for a Higher Apprenticeship you'll need one of the following:

- Four GCSEs (C or above, or Grade 4-9) including Maths and English
- One A-Level or equivalent qualification, such as:
 - BTEC National Qualification
 - Advanced Diploma in Construction or Built Environment
 - Other access or foundation courses

Those completing the Higher Apprenticeship will automatically be enrolled onto the Degree Apprenticeship following completion.

However, if you possess one of the following then you may be able to join the Degree Apprenticeship programme directly:

- A Cert HE in a Construction related subject
- HNC in Construction or equivalent qualifications
- Access at least 45 credits at level 3 and 15 credits at level 2 from a relevant Open College Network accredited course

More experienced entrants without formal qualifications will be considered on merit, accounting for factors such as work experience, previous qualifications or skills gained from the Armed Forces.



To join a Degree Apprenticeship in Real Estate, you must also have a keen interest in customer expectation and commercial needs. It's a big commitment: you'll need manage real work in the office and on-site while furthering your education.

To qualify for a Degree Apprenticeship, you'll need the following:

- GCSEs (grade C or above, or grades 4-9) in Maths, English and a science subject plus:
- 112 UCAS points from at least two A levels or equivalent BTEC National qualifications.
 For example:
 - BBC at A Level
 - DMM in BTEC Extended Diploma
 - A combination of qualifications, which may include AS Levels, EPQ and general studies.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Applications open

Remember, selection is a two-way process. We want to find out more about you, but you need to ask about us too.

Applications open in February, although we'd recommend you apply as soon as possible, as some locations close their vacancies early.

2. Apply online

3. Video interview

If successful, you'll be invited to participate in a video interview, where you'll be asked about your key skills, commercial awareness and motivations.

4. University application

If successful at the video interview stage, you'll complete a University application to check your eligibility against the entry criteria.

5. Final interview & presentation exercise

Final interviews and presentation exercises will take place from May onwards with a Director from your local office.



6. Job offer

Successful applicants will receive their offers from May onwards. We'll also help you complete the remainder of your University eligibility activities which include:

- A self-assessment of your current knowledge, skills and behaviour
- A functional skills review
- A conversation with a Work-Based Learning Coach

7. Start your job

You'll start with us from October, with your induction at Sheffield Hallam University taking place the following January.
